

WEDNESDAY TWILIGHT RACE PROCEDURES

Issued on 4 October 2004
Revised on 4 September 2005

1. WEDNESDAY TWILIGHT RACES – SUMMER SEASON

- 1.1. The Wednesday Twilight Race is a club social race and **no spinnakers or similar** are permitted.
- 1.2. The race will be a handicap start with a nominal time of 1700 hours.
- 1.3. Handicap start time for each yacht entered in the series will be published on the notice board beside the main entrance of the club before midday on the day of each race.
- 1.4. The course will be Start-WC(Wedding Cake)-SAL(Salamander Bay)-Finish.
- 1.5. Each yacht will be required to record her **elapsed time** for the race on the Finish Sheet in the clubhouse.
- 1.6. The **elapsed time** is the **difference** in times taken between **crossing the start line** and **crossing the finish line**.
- 1.7. Yachts are expected to cross the line as close as possible to their advised start time.
- 1.8. Failure to notify the elapsed time by 2130 on the day of the race may result in a DNS for the race.

2. WEDNESDAY TWILIGHT RACES – WINTER SEASON

- 2.1. The Wednesday Twilight Race is a club social race and **no spinnakers or similar** are permitted.
- 2.2. The race will be a handicap start with a nominal start time as advised on the notice of race.
- 2.3. Handicap start time for each yacht entered in the series will be published on the notice board beside the main entrance of the club before midday on the day of each race.
- 2.4. The course will be Start-WC(Wedding Cake)-WB(West Bank)-Finish.
- 2.5. Each yacht will be required to record her **elapsed time** for the race on the Finish Sheet in the clubhouse.
- 2.6. The **elapsed time** is the **difference** in times taken between **crossing the start line** and **crossing the finish line**.
- 2.7. Yachts are expected to cross the line as close as possible to their advised start time.
- 2.8. Failure to notify the elapsed time by 2130 on the day of the race may result in a DNS for the race.
