

SPRINT RACE PROCEDURES

October 2008

1. RACE SCHEDULE

- 1.1. Sprint races are inshore races.
- 1.2. Sprint races start at the PSYC start/finish line at 1300 hours in accordance with the PSYC race schedule.
- 1.3. Four races will be scheduled for the day.
- 1.4. The start of the second, third races and fourth will be at the discretion of the race officer but no more than 30 minutes after the first boat yacht has finished the previous race.
- 1.5. Changes will be notified in the Notice of Race or as per the Sailing Instructions.

2. THE COURSES AND MARKS

- 2.1. The course shall be 3 orange buoys B1 east of the start line, B2 west of the start line and B3 to the north.
- 2.2. Courses as on the 2008-9 course sheet.
- 2.3. The course shall be identified with code flag U
- 2.4. Middle Island shall be passed to the South on all legs.

3. START and FINISH LINES

- 3.1. The club start/finish line is a transit line through the PSYC signal mast and the white pole at the water's edge in the vicinity of the mast.
- 3.2. The following flags may be displayed from the signal mast
 - 3.2.1. **RED** Keep all marks to port
 - 3.2.2. **GREEN** Keep all marks to starboard
 - 3.2.3. **E** First Mark is to the East of the start line
 - 3.2.4. **W** First Mark is to the West of the start line
- 3.3. See Sailing Instructions for additional information.

4. SCORING

- 4.1. See Race Handicapping and Scoring System.
- 4.2. Handicaps will be decided by the handicapper.
- 4.3. Three races to count.
- 4.4. Points from a yachts best three races in each heat in the Sprint Series will be accumulated to calculate the series winner.
