NOTICE OF RACE

PSYC Max and Edna Berman Race 2027

1. RACE FORMAT

- 1.1. The event is to commemorate the contribution of founding members Max and Edna Berman
- 1.2. The race is a single division, standalone event with extras
- 1.3. Participants are encouraged to invite family, guests and club volunteers to join the race
- 1.4. The race results and prize presentation will be conducted in the clubhouse

2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS (SI)

- 2.1. Refer to the SI for Organising Authority, Rules, Eligibility and Entry, Fees, Safety, Disclaimer of Liability and Insurance
- 2.2. The SI are available from the PSYC website

3. NOTICE OF RACE

- 3.1. If there is a conflict between this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, the Notice of Race shall take precedence

4. STARTING AND FINISHING

- 4.1. Refer SI section 12 'Starting and Finishing'
- 4.2. The race will start at 1200hrs or as directed by the Race Officer

5. RACECOURSE

- 5.1. The default course regardless of wind direction shall be:
START - WC - MB(P) - SB - MB - WB - FINISH
- 5.2. Alterations to the course are at the discretion of the Race Officer

6. HANDICAPPING

- 6.1. Handicaps for this event will be a boat's average of all passage race PHS handicaps (CHC) in the previous year or as determined by the race committee

7. SCORING AND PRIZES

- 7.1. Prizes will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place with 1st place also receiving the Max and Edna Berman perpetual trophy
- 7.2. Prizes are awarded at the sole discretion of the PSYC board

8. PENALTIES

- 8.1. As per RRS 44.2, the 720-degree penalty turn is reduced to 360-degree for short duration races and is applicable to this event
