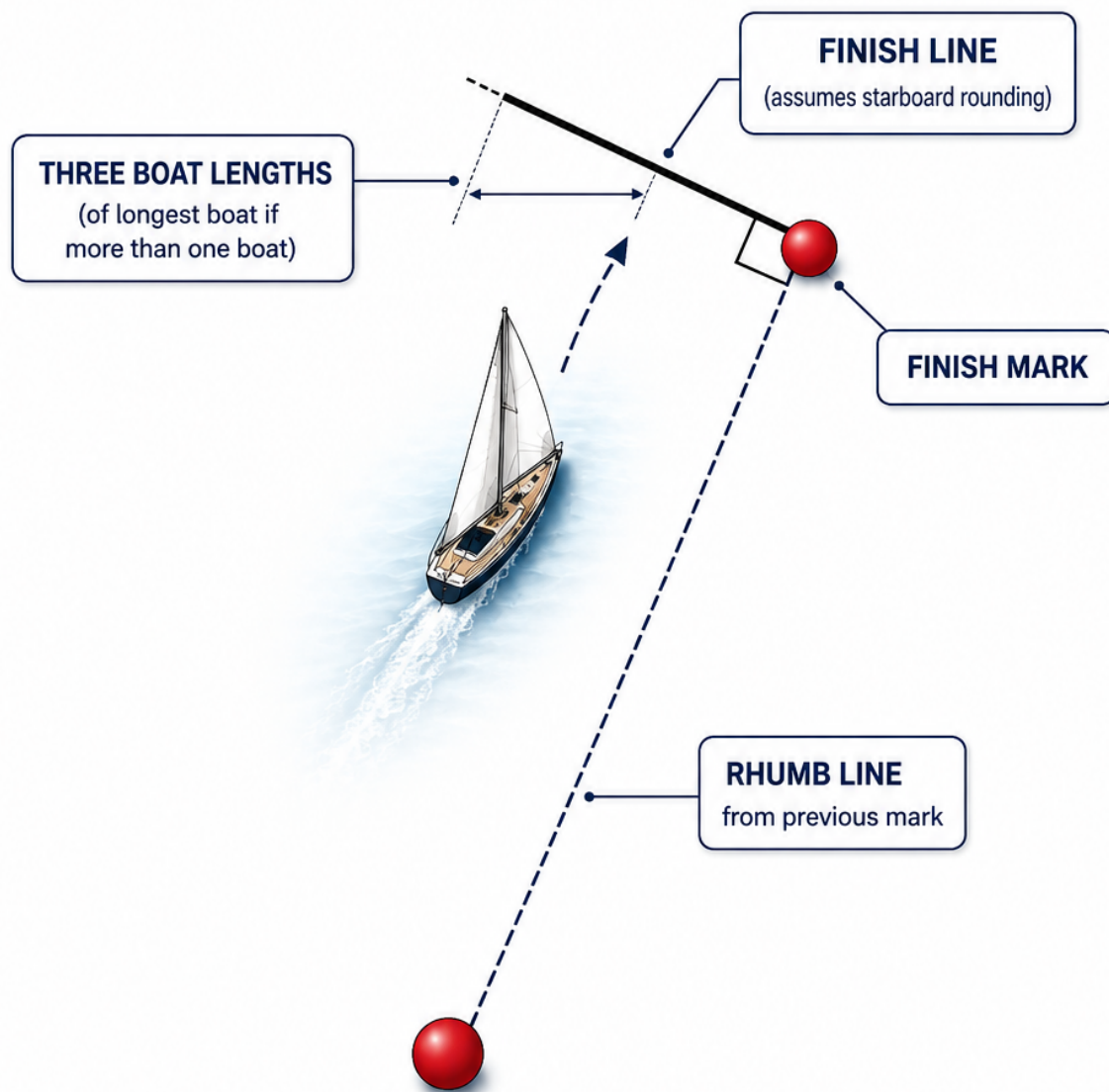


FINISHING AT AN ISOLATED MARK

The diagram below shows the default finish line when there is no other buoy, vessel or landmark bounding the finish line and it is not otherwise defined in an official document. This is often the case when shortening a course.

The rounding direction of the new finish mark is as per the published racecourse.

The diagram below depicts a starboard rounding.



START / FINISH LINE

For races starting or finishing at a mark and unless otherwise defined, the start/finish line shall be between the nominated mark and a committee boat or additional laid mark OR a transit perpendicular to the rhumb line between the mark and the previous (if finishing) or next (if starting) mark. The line is bounded by the mark and a 3-boat length zone on the course side of the mark.
